Elements of an Arctic Declaration

Parties will:

- not authorize their vessels to fish in the central Arctic high seas area until proper science and an appropriate management regime exist.
- establish a joint program of scientific research in order to improve understanding of Arctic Ocean ecosystems.
- coordinate monitoring, control and surveillance activities in Arctic high seas area.
- ensure that non-commercial fishing does not undermine the purpose of the interim measures, is based on scientific advice and is monitored, and that data obtained through any such fishing is shared.
- encourage other States to take measures with vessels flying their flags consistent with the interim measures.
