


No BOWFEST flight today due to forecasted high winds, including a small craft advisory. Winds were forecasted to be 30 kt so we scheduled a pilot down day.

Synopsis...A TROUGH OF LOW PRESSURE OFF THE ARCTIC COAST NORTH OF BARROW TO DEMARCATION POINT WILL MOVE SLOWLY NORTH THROUGH SUNDAY. A 977 MB LOW WILL REMAIN NEARLY STATIONARY NORTHEAST OF THE KAMCHATKA COAST THROUGH MONDAY. AN ASSOCIATED WEATHER FRONT MOVING EAST ACROSS THE CENTRAL BERING SEA WILL STALL JUST WEST OF SAINT LAWRENCE ISLAND SUNDAY NIGHT THEN GRADUALLY WEAKEN THROUGH MONDAY.
