Area flown: Transect lines 10, 12 and 14, partial.

Weather and visibility: Skies were partly cloudy to overcast. Sea state ranged from Beaufort 5-6. Visibility ranged from 0-10 km, with low ceilings and fog both nearshore and offshore of all transects. There was no ice present within the area surveyed. Extensive fog, low ceilings and high sea states precluded complete coverage of transect lines.
