

## COMIDA – Flight 212 – 6 July 2011

Area flown: Transect line 12, partial; coastal transect from the nearshore end of line 14 to Pt. Barrow.

Total hours flown: 2.9

Total transect hours: 1.7

Number of bowheads seen: 0 (0 calves)

Weather and visibility: Skies were partly cloudy, with brief periods of clear, throughout the area surveyed. Sea state ranged from Beaufort 2-6; high sea states precluded complete coverage of transect line 12. Visibility was 0 to 10 km, with an area of fog west of Pt. Barrow. Ice cover ranged from 0-50% broken floe.

Sightings: One walrus and an unidentified small pinniped.
