Modeling Fisher Behavior under Changing Policies, Economics, and Environmental Conditions

Fisheries management involves managing people as well as developing an understanding of different target and non-target species. This talk provides an overview of spatial economic analyses conducted at AFSC over the last decade that address how fishers and fish processors in different Alaska fisheries have been impacted by changing regulations, economics, and environmental conditions. We also discuss the value and challenges of different data sources used in these analyses. More generally, what are the primary opportunities to more fully integrate social and natural science research at AFSC? How do we best utilize this work in fisheries management?
